Position Description

This position will be focused in the Hawaii region of American Marine Corporation. These responsibilities include oversight of the Marine Construction and Dredging business line's management team and their subordinates. He/she is responsible for the business line's P & L, financial analysis/control and overall business planning as guided and with oversight from the Vice President AMC (HI).

Primary Areas of Responsibility

- Oversee and direct marine construction and dredging projects from conception to completion.
